A special meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Newton was held on the above date at 6:45 p.m. Present were Mrs. Diglio, Mrs. Becker, Deputy Mayor Flynn, Mr. Levante, Mayor Elvidge and Municipal Clerk, Lorraine A. Read.

The Town Council held an interview for a current vacancy on the Newton Housing Authority.

At 6:45 p.m., the Governing Body interviewed William Nannery who expressed an interest in serving on the Newton Housing Authority. Mr. Nannery introduced himself and outlined his interests for serving on the Newton Housing Authority. Mr. Nannery is currently employed by the County of Sussex Public Works Department. Mayor Elvidge advised as a member of the Newton Housing Authority you must complete a comprehensive training program consisting of required and elective courses.
