The Newton Advisory Board of Health held a regular meeting on the above date at 7:00 p.m. Dr. Nancy Craddock, Dr. John Craddock, Mr. William Hagaman and Mrs. Lorraine Read, Secretary were in attendance. Christine Davey, Health Inspector from the Sussex County Board of Health was also present. Dr. John Ford, Rev. Richard Carlson were excused.

Dr. Nancy Craddock made the following declaration that "in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act, notice of this regular meeting was given to the two newspapers of record and posted on the official bulletin board on December 31, 2013."

Upon motion of Dr. Nancy Craddock, seconded by Dr. John Craddock and carried, the minutes of March 27, 2013 Regular meeting was approved.

Under Old Business, Mrs. Read updated the Board on the Junk Dealers license. It was noted that the public health nuisance violation issued to Newton Auto Salvage for tire storage has been abated and a Junk Dealers license has been issued to Mr. Sesera, owner of Newton Auto Salvage for the remainder of 2013.

Under New Business, Mrs. Read and Mrs. Davey reviewed the routine health notices submitted by the Sussex County Health Department. Mrs. Davey updated the Board members on various health issues and addressed all questions.

Mrs. Read also updated the Board on the issues being addressed on Mt. View Street. Mrs. Davey outlined her findings during her inspection of the property. She noted her limited access to the rear of property as well as the house. Mrs. Davey will continue to work with the Town Officials regarding this property.

Dr. Nancy Craddock opened the meeting to the public.
