A special meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Newton was held on the above date at 6:30 p.m. Present were Mrs. Becker, Mrs. Le Frois, Mr. Ricciardo, Mayor Elvidge and Town Clerk, Lorraine Read. Mrs. Unhoch was excused.

The Town Council held two interviews for the current vacancies on the Newton Advisory Recreation Commission and the Historic Preservation Advisory Commission.

The governing body first interviewed Ms. Amanda Best who expressed interest in serving on either the Historic Preservation Advisory Commission or the Advisory Recreation Commission.

Ms. Best introduced herself and advised Council of her background and interest in serving. Ms. Best is employed in Newton and provides pro bono legal services to Project Self Sufficiency and is interested in getting involved with the Town of Newton.

The Town Council then interviewed Mr. James Schmitt. Mr. Schmitt outlined his background and interest in serving on either the Advisory Shade Tree Commission, Newton Housing Authority, or the Advisory Recreation Commission. Mr. Schmitt would like to get involved in the Town of Newton. The Council explained the duties of each board and commission of interest.

Ms. Best and Mr. Schmitt were advised of the date and time of the Historic Preservation Advisory Commission meetings as well as the Advisory Recreation Commission meetings.

After a brief discussion, the consensus of the governing body was to appoint Ms. Amanda Best to the Historic Preservation Advisory Commission and Mr. James Schmitt to the Newton Advisory Recreation Commission to fill the current vacancies.

A formal resolution authorizing these appointments will be made a part of next regular Council meeting to be held on Monday, June 28, 2010.
