The Newton Advisory Board of Health held a regular meeting on the above date at 7:00 p.m. Dr. Nancy Craddock, Dr. John Craddock, Dr. John Ford, Mr. William Hagaman, and Mrs. Lorraine A. Read, Secretary were in attendance. Rev. Richard Carlson was excused. Christine Davey, Health Inspector from the Sussex County Board of Health, was also present.

Dr. Nancy Craddock made the following declaration that "in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act, notice of this public meeting was given to the two newspapers of record and posted on the official bulletin board on December 31, 2010."

Upon motion of Mr. Hagaman, seconded by Dr. Ford and carried, the minutes of September 22, 2010 meeting was approved. It was noted that the March 23, 2010 meeting was cancelled.

Under Old Business, the Board members re-addressed the potential of licensing Boarding Homes in the Town of Newton. The Board suggested reaching out to the Department of Community Affairs (DCA) for information. After a brief discussion, Mrs. Read advised that she will further research additional avenues for Boarding Home Licensing.

Under New Business, Mrs. Davey reviewed the routine health notices submitted by the Sussex County Health Department. Board members had questions which were addressed by Mrs. Davey.

Dr. Nancy Craddock opened the meeting to the public.

There being no one from the public to be heard, upon motion of Dr. Ford, seconded by Dr. John Craddock and carried, the meeting adjourned at 8:32 p.m.
