The Newton Advisory Board of Health held a regular meeting on the above date at 7:07 p.m. VIA ZOOM. Present were Dr. Nancy Craddock, Dr. John Craddock, Dr. Beatrix Bueno and Mrs. Lorraine Read, BOH Secretary were in attendance. Mr. William Hagaman was absent. Melissa McGill, Health Inspector from the Sussex County Board of Health and Terri Oswin, Deputy Clerk/Deputy Town Manager were also present.

Dr. Nancy Craddock made the following declaration that “in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act, notice of this regular meeting was given to the two newspapers of record and posted on the official bulletin board on January 4, 2021.”

Prior to approval of minutes, Mrs. Read introduced Terri Oswin, Deputy Clerk/Deputy Town Manager, who will be taking over as Secretary of the BOH due to Mrs. Read’s retirement.

Upon motion of Dr. J. Craddock, seconded by Dr. Bueno and carried, the minutes of March 24, 2021 Regular meeting were unanimously approved.

Dr. Nancy Craddock, noting our recent annual drinking water report, asked about testing our water for PFAS and was advised by Mrs. Oswin she will inquire with the Town Engineer and notify the Board of her findings.
